In 1999, he completed his master's thesis titled "The Ethical Relevance of Implicit Knowledge" on ethics and epistemology, under the supervision of Arnold Burms, and in 2012, he submitted his doctoral thesis under the supervision of Betül Çotuksöken, on ontology, logic and philosophy of education, titled "The Meaning of the Concept of Universitas in Kant's Philosophy and Its Relationship with the University Institution". He was one of the founding professors of Kocaeli University Philosophy Department under the chairmanship of Nejat Bozkurt and has given lectures in Turkish or English in almost every field of philosophy since 2000. She has scientific articles in national and international academic journals and papers in international congresses. He published his novel *Bir Devr-i Alem Safranbolu Masalı* in 2010 and *Autroduction to Philosophy* in 2014 with Kübra Demir Bilgiç. In 2016, he published *Antropogonia (Natural and Cultural Evolution of Intelligence)* and together with *Philosophy, Science and University*, a second novel called *Hypnotic Chess* and *Kamelya (A Social History Study Through Kamile Bilgiç Poems)*. His final book *Critique of Rationality*, his main theory of philosophy of mind was published in 2022.
